Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers, Yachtsmen and Seafarers

Acoustic Doppler Current Profilers (ADCPs) – Deployment in Kenmare

The Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport has been advised that there will be a deployment of ADCP current meters on the sea floor in Kenmare, Co. Kerry. Current meters will be mounted in a stainless-steel frame at the location provided below¹:

ADCP	Latitude	Longitude
1	51°51'34.51"N	009°38'01.31"W

The stainless-steel frame will be deployed from vessel **"An tOileanach"** (Callsign **EI5930**). There will be continuous VHF watch on Channels 23 and 16 during the deployment.

A surface spar style buoy will be used to mark locations. The Buoy will be a 700mm diameter yellow buoy of height approximately 1000mm above the water line. The buoy will be fitted with a flashing LED light with a range of 2-3 nautical miles. The light will be set to flash 3 (Y) times every 10 seconds (duration of flash 0.3 seconds).

The duration of deployment is 14 days, commencing 02/09/2019. Please note the deployment date is subject to weather conditions.
